## COVID "Step 3" Operations 2021

### General Information

In order to ensure Hardwood is safe and fun for all, a number of changes will be implemented in accordance with local health directives issued for businesses operating in the Step 2 plan of reopening as per O.Reg 364/20. This guide will explain our most up-to-date Standard Operating Procedures and COVID precautions. All staff are subject to a daily health and wellness screening, with home isolation and/or testing done as required. We ask that you do not visit Hardwood Ski and Bike if you feel unwell, or if anyone in your household or work environment is ill. These precautions will help minimize the transmission of COVID within the resort environment, while maximizing the ability for guests to take full advantage of the resort this season.

### COVID Screening & Contact Tracing

Daily Covid screening is mandatory for all program participants and event participants. Canatrace link can be found on our website or [here](#), and is best if done with your smartphone. You will present your screening check upon arrival at the program/event check in area. Staff and contractors are required to provide screening daily.

### Trail Passes

Trail Passes must be purchased online [here](#). Redeem/pick up your trail pass at the ticket booth on weekends, holidays and after 4pm on weekdays. Monday to Friday 9am to 4pm passes will be available for redemption/pick up at the main chalet.

### Parking

Parking will be in the main "lower" lot unless the upper lot is open. Your car will be your "home base" and all baggage, food and nonessentials must remain in your car for the duration of your visit. No bag storage, change rooms or dining areas will be available inside the Chalet.

### Chalet Use

A maximum capacity of **200 persons** will be allowed inside the Chalet at any one time, as per step 3 regulations (allowing all patrons to maintain a distance of 2m from others).

There is a single entrance and exit at the front of the Chalet. Masks are required at all times while inside the Chalet. Hand sanitizer is available (and recommended for use) at the entrance and at service areas. Touch points will be sanitized multiple times during the day using a certified disinfectant.

Washrooms will be open and cleaned frequently to ensure a sanitary condition. Please note that at some times during the day, a washroom might be closed for a short duration for a deep cleaning. Please be respectful of cleaners, as their efforts are required for our continued operation. Changing in the washrooms is prohibited.

No Bag Storage or Change Rooms will be available.

No indoor dining at any time. Take out food is permissible. Please enjoy in your vehicle or at the picnic tables.

### **Outdoor**

Please maintain a physical distance of 2 meters between users not within your household.

### **Retail Shop**

The Retail Shop will be open for in person shopping/service. Phone and email orders are also available (Retail@HardwoodSkiandBike.ca). Mask wearing, capacity rules and physical distancing must be followed at all times. Online Retail is also available [here](#).

The West Wing doors are for emergency use only, and not to be used as an entrance/exit for any other reason.

### **Service & Repair**

Hardwood's Service & Repair Shop is open. Additional sanitation and quarantining of some items may cause longer than normal lead times, but this will be discussed at the time of dropoff. A full list of our services and pricing is available online [here](#).

### **Rentals**

Hardwood's Rental offerings will be available for online reservations with curbside pickup. Disinfecting of the rental equipment includes sanitizing of the handlebars, saddle, and toptube of all bicycles using a certified disinfectant before and after each use. Helmets will be sprayed with certified disinfectant before and after each use, and rented no more than once daily. Additional sanitation and quarantining of some items may cause longer than normal lead times. A full list of our rental offerings is available online [here](#).

### **Food Service**

Myke's Big Mouth Food Truck will be open on Weekends and holidays from 11am to 4pm, and on select Weekdays from 11am to 2 pm.

Grab 'n' Go snack items will be available at Guest Services.

Additional notes regarding food/dining:

- No indoor dining shall be permitted.
- Please use available garbage bins or take your garbage with you. Please do not litter.

### **Trail Etiquette**

All of our trails are clearly signed and one way only. If you need to pass another trail user, call your pass and allow at least 2 meters distance to pass.

### **Headquarters (HQ) and The Odell Building**

Headquarters is for staff use only. No other users will be permitted.

### **Programs & Lessons**

Adult and children's lessons and programs are running at this time with safety protocols in place. All participants must show their covid screening and maintain 2m distance from instructors and others not from their household. Contact Guest Services for private lessons at 705.487.3775.
