

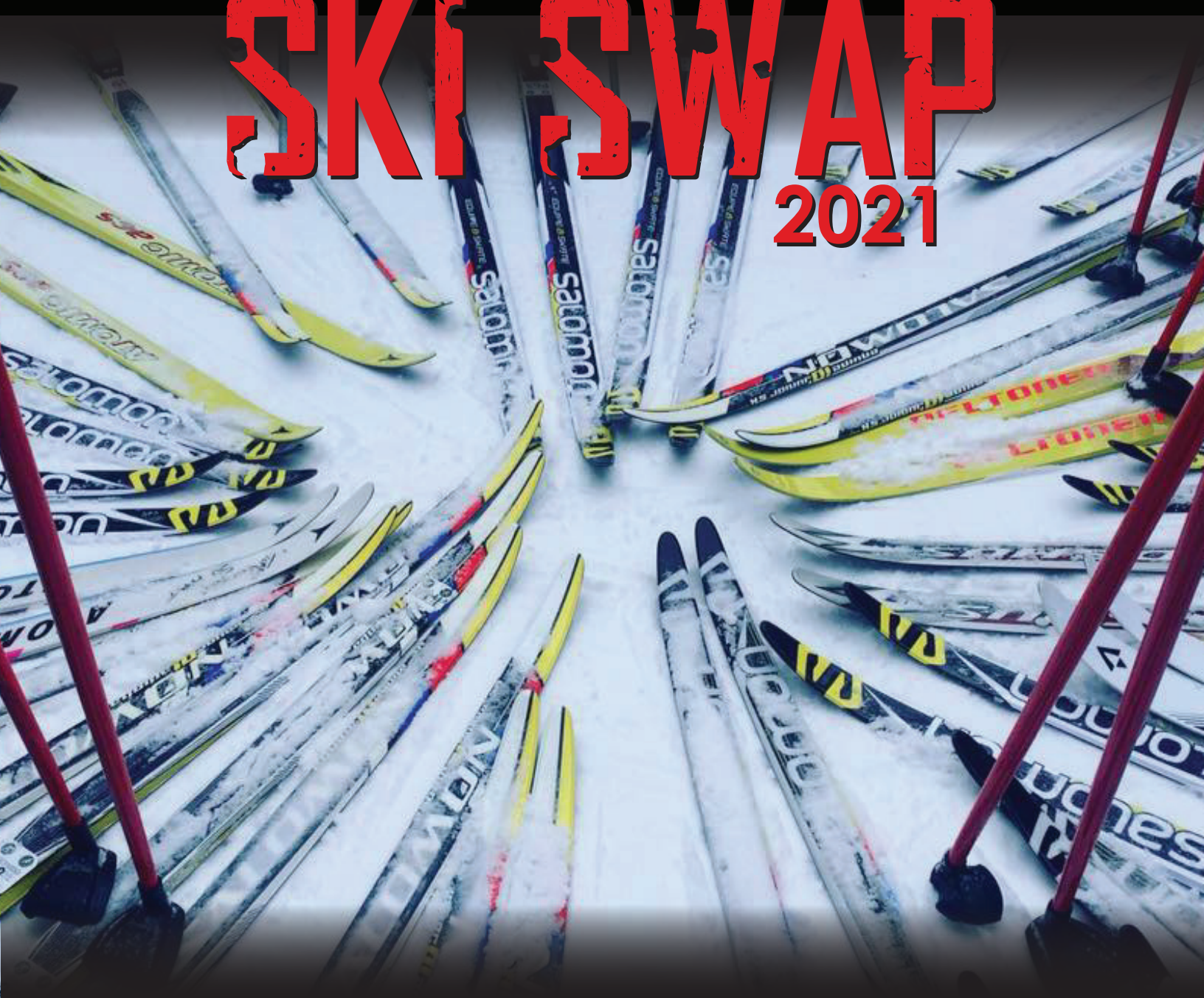

General Information

The 2021 Ski Swap will run October 16th and 17th. The days are open to all, but entry to the event **must** be reserved in advance by online registration. Those not on our list will not be admitted.

Registration

In order to manage the number of shoppers and ensure a safe space for all, this year's Ski Swap will be by appointment only. Shoppers will be allowed to register for the Ski Swap per time block.

Shopping times will run in blocks of 90 minutes starting at 9 AM on Saturday and 12:30 PM on Sunday, with a 15 minute break between blocks. Shoppers may only enter the swap within their allotted time block; shoppers do not need to arrive exactly at the start of their block. Coloured stamps will be used to ensure ease of in-and-outs while shopping.

In an effort to ensure blocks are filled fairly, a \$5 per person fee will be charged at registration. This fee can be used as Ski Swap credit for purchases of at least \$5. Fee will not be refunded for no shows, cancellations, or those who leave the Ski Swap without a purchase from the Swap or Retail Store. All Ski Swap sales are final.

Please note that if the government disallows the gatherings of certain group numbers, we may be forced to modify attendees per block or cancel the Ski Swap. In this case, the \$5 per person fee will not be refunded, due to costs already incurred.

COVID Precautions

In addition to our standard operating procedures, Hardwood will be implementing several Ski Swap specific protocols.

- All items will be required to be sanitized and left in quarantine 24-hours before being moved into the swap.
- There will be only one entrance and one exit through the front doors of the Chalet.
- Masks will be required for all shoppers.
- Hand sanitizer and garbage stations will be set up around the Ski Swap.
- Day users will not be allowed access to the Ski Swap and will use separate bathrooms.
- Electronic payment is encouraged and preferred.

Item Intake/Pick-up

Please note that Hardwood has made many changes to this year's item intake. Please note that if the government disallows the gatherings of groups, we may be forced to cancel the Ski Swap. In this case, the \$3.50 per item fee will not be refunded, due to costs already incurred.

- **Items may only be dropped off:**
 - October 1st until October 14th, from 10 AM to 4 PM
- All items must be sanitized prior to intake. Hardwood will supply cleaning supplies for this purpose.
- Items will remain untouched for 24-hours before entering the sale.

- Absolutely no intake will be accepted during the Ski Swap, or outside the above mentioned dates and times.
- A fee of \$3.50 per item will be charged for pricing and ticketing services.
- There are two remuneration options for Ski Swap Sellers.
 - Option 1 - Full Value Certificate
 - The value of all items sold is redeemed at 100%. A certificate will be issued to be redeemed in store with an expiry date of Oct 31, 2021.
 - Option 2 - 80% Cheque
 - Starting October 20th, you may pick up a cheque for 80% of the sold value. If you are unable to pick up a cheque, they will be mailed out after November 1st.
- Any unsold items must be picked up by November 1st. Any items not picked up by November 1st will be considered a donation to Hardwood.

Retail Shop/Service & Repair/Food Service

The Retail Shop will be open for shopping to registered Ski Swap Shoppers. Service & Repair Shop is open to the public, but by escort/curbside drop off only. Grab and Go food items are available in the Chalet. Big Mouth Food Truck is available from outside only.
