Late Fee:

Entries received after the FFebruary 21 1pm deadline are subject to a \$15/skier late fee, no exceptions. Substitutes will be subject to a \$15/skier fee as well.

General Information:

- Teams should try to be on site by 9:30am to secure bibs and make necessary changes. Lost bibs will be charged to the school @ \$50/bib.
- Coaches, upon arrival are to proceed directly to get coaches' package.(Odell Building)
- Course length, starting procedures, time and order of races are all subject to change, at Conviener's discretion.
- Skiers will start in intervals one skier every 15 seconds. All skiers should be at the start 10 minutes before their start time. There will be one lane tracked out of the start for 30 meters. Skiers must double pole only until the end of the lane. They may skate after this point.
