

General Information

The 2023 Ski Swap will run from October 14th to 22nd.

The Saturday (October 14th) entry to Swap **must** be reserved in advance by online registration. Those not on our list **will not** be admitted on Saturday (October 14th). Saturday shopping times will run in blocks of 90 minutes starting at 9 AM, with a 15 minute break between blocks. Shoppers may only enter the swap within their allotted time block; shoppers do not need to arrive exactly at the start of their block. In an effort to ensure blocks are filled fairly, a \$10 per person fee will be charged at registration. This fee can be recuperated as Ski Swap credit for purchases of at least \$10 before tax (Fees may only be recuperated individually). Fee will not be refunded for no-shows, cancellations, or those who leave the Ski Swap without a purchase from the Swap or Retail Store.

Starting Sunday, October 15th through to Sunday, October 22nd Swap is open to all visitors with no reservation required. No fee will be charged, and no discount will be applied to purchases.

Registration

Register for Saturday, October 14th, [here](#). All customers 6 years of age and older must register to be admitted.

Sunday, October 15th to Sunday, October 22nd no registration is required. (First come, first served.)

Item Intake/Pick-up

Items may only be dropped off:

- September 25th until October 14th, from 10 AM to 4 PM

Item Intake Information

- A fee of \$3.50 per item will be charged for pricing and ticketing services (except on Saturday, October 14th when fee is \$5.00 per item).
- A fee of \$5.00 per item will be charged for pricing and ticketing services on Saturday, October 14th. The increased fee on Saturday is due to the extra work associated with drop-offs during the Ski Swap. We strongly encourage early dropoff if possible. **Only registered shoppers will be permitted into the Swap on Saturday, October 14th**, even if you are dropping off equipment on that day.
- Items that will be accepted into the Swap include: Nordic Skis, Nordic Boots, Nordic Poles, Snowshoes, Roller Skis, Ski Bags, Nordic Bindings, Pulks (Child Carrier). **No Clothing.**

There are two remuneration options for Ski Swap Sellers:

- Option 1 - Full Value Certificate
 - The value of all items sold is redeemed at 100%. A certificate will be issued to be redeemed in the Hardwood store with an expiry date of October 31, 2023.
- Option 2 - 80% Cheque
 - Starting October 25th, you may pick up a cheque for 80% of the sold value. If you are unable to pick up a cheque, they will be mailed out after November 1st.

Item Pickup Information:

- Any unsold items must be picked up by October 31st. Any items not picked up by October 31st will be considered a donation to Hardwood Ski and Bike.

Retail Shop/Service & Repair/Food Service**Saturday, October 14th (Reserved Shopping Blocks)**

- The Retail Shop will be open for shopping only to registered Ski Swap Shoppers on Saturday (October 14th).
- Service & Repair Shop will be open to the public, but by escort/curbside drop off only.
- Food Service at the food trailer will be open to the public via the patio.
- Grab and Go food items are available in the Chalet to registered shoppers.

- The Retail Shop will be open to all Hardwood visitors.
- Service & Repair Shop is open to all Hardwood visitors.
